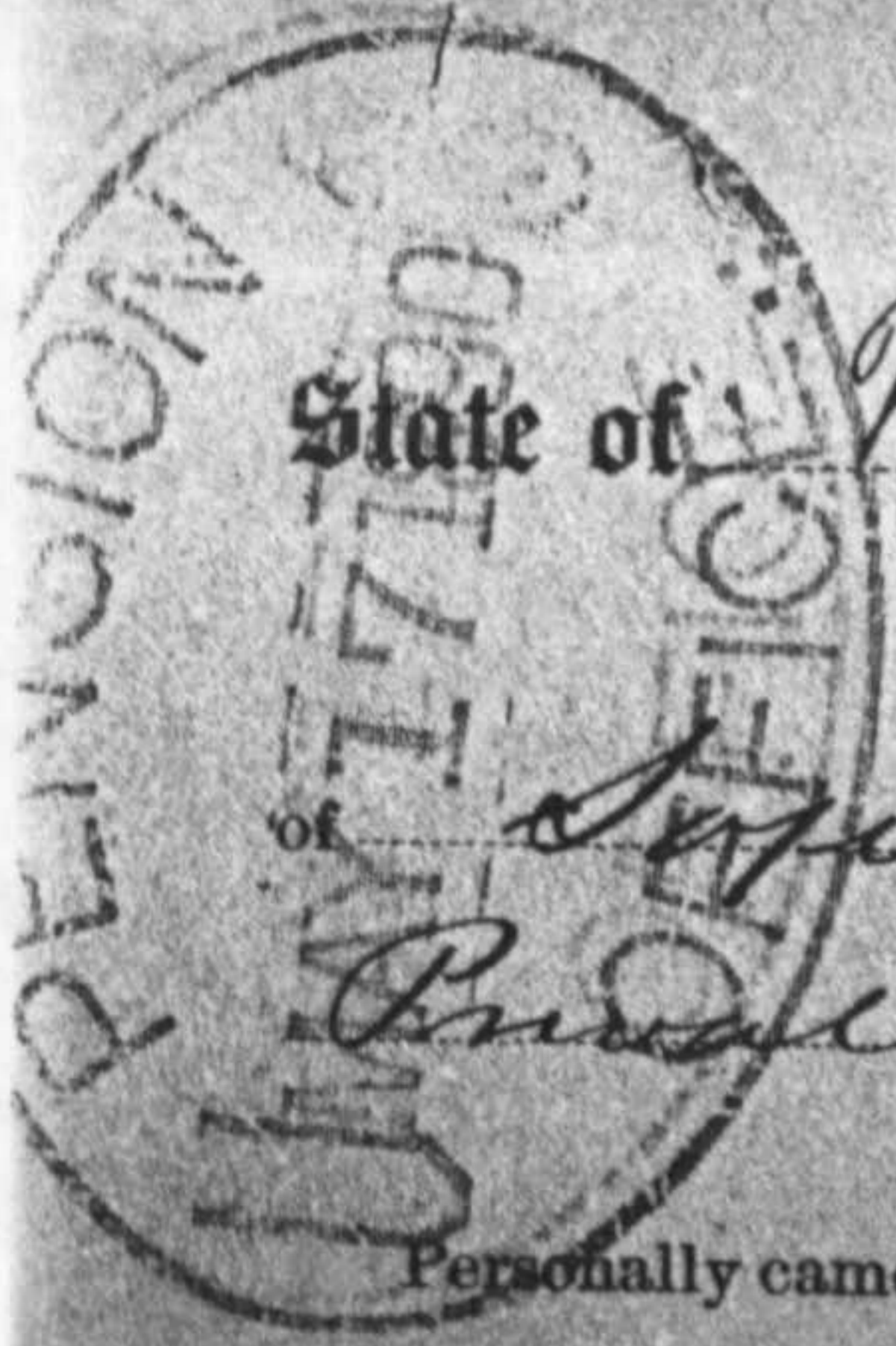


PHYSICIAN'S AFFIDAVIT.

well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and who, being duly sworn, declares in relation to aforesaid case as follows:

That he is a Practicing Physician, and that he has been acquainted with said soldier for about 18 years, and that

He attended Isaac Queen soon after he came out of army for an incipient attack of disease of lungs, and continued to attend at different times for similar disease, "Phtisis Pulmonalis" up to time of his death which occurred March 28th. 1883.

From facts I can learn said Isaac Queen was a healthy and sound man previous to his enlisting in U.S. A, and was not suffering with above mentioned disease of which he died.
