*Butter*, who, being by me first duly sworn to answertruly all interrogatories propounded to her during this Special Examination of aforesaid  
pension claim, deposes and says: I am about 50 yearsof age, house wife - My husband Rev,  
Saml. C. Butler, is preacher of the Durham  
st Church this City - I reside and my  
P.O. address is # 1008 Wolfe st, Balto, Md.

I have known the Clmt, for  
the last 20 years - she was living  
with her husband Isaac Queen on Carlton  
st, when I first met her. I considered  
her, as did all the neighbors, the  
wife of Isaac Queen, and she has  
continued his widow since death. I  
cant say when he died. its been  
several years past, I cant say cause  
of death. I remember of four children  
of clmts, all of them were the children  
of Isaac Queen. Names of children were  
Nicholas (oldest) ~~Samuel~~ <sup>Jamley</sup> (next age) Florence (next)  
Seward (next) and Leibo the youngest. I do not  
know the age of Nicholas. but suppose he is 2 or  
3 years older than Saml, who was born in  
June or Feby 1871. I fix this date as I was  
living across the street from clmt, when  
Saml. was born and I gave birth to my son  
Daniel on the June 8<sup>th</sup> 1871 - and I will remember  
that Daniel was born about 5 months before  
said Clmt, son Saml. I think Florence  
is about 2 or 3 years younger than Saml,
