BASIS OF CLAIM.

Alleges in declaration filed May 6, 1878. "That at Camp Belger Baltimore Md. fall of 1864. he was wounded by a musket ball through right thigh: that he was on guard duty at night, guarding recruits; that they attempted to escape, several shots were fired by the other guards to prevent them & that the shot of one of the guards struck him as stated above"
