

DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF ITS SEAL.

On this 2nd day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight personally appeared before me, Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore, a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Boone aged about 42 years, a resident of the ... of H. Leonard's P.O., county of Calvert, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares

that he is the identical James Boone who was ENROLLED on the 24th day of March, 1864, in Company B of the 39th Regiment of M.C. Troops commanded by Lindon (Captain) and was honorably DISCHARGED at Wilmington N.C. on the 4th day of December, 1865; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 42 years; height 5 feet 2 inches; complexion, Black; hair, Black; eyes, Black.

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Camp Belge in Baltimore, in the State of Maryland on or about the ... day of fall of 1864, he was wounded by a musket ball

being shot through the right thigh - he was on

on guard at night - at said camp - engaged in guard duty he was ... they attempted to escape - several shots were fired by the other guards to prevent them from escaping, and the shot of one of the other guards struck and wounded him as aforesaid - he was sent to the hospital ... and weak in his right leg

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates

in the King's U.S. Gen Hospital at Baltimore Md for about two months, and then by the Surgeon at Camp Belge

That he has never been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the Camp of Calvert in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a Farmer

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Farmer. That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, R. E. Wright of Baltimore State of Maryland, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has never received but one application which application he thinks was never filed for a Pension. That his POST OFFICE ADDRESS is H. Leonard's P.O. county of Calvert State of Maryland
