

B DECLARATION FOR THE INCREASE OF AN INVALID PENSION. B

On this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ~~eighty~~ <sup>eighty</sup> one, personally appeared before me, Samuel L. Green, Clerk Circuit Court for Calvert County, the same being a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Boon, aged 75 years, a resident of Calvert County, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, duly enrolled at the Washington D. C. Pension Agency at the rate of two dollars per month, by reason of disability incurred in the military service of the United States while (1) Private of Co. C 87<sup>th</sup> Regt U.S.C. Troops that his present physical condition is such that he believes himself entitled to receive an increased pension; and that he herewith returns his present pension certificate.

He further declares that he is disabled in the following manner, to wit: (2) right leg is greatly disabled from wound received at Camp Belger in Fall of 1864, while guarding recruits as night-guard, the recruits attempted to escape, and that said wound is much more painful than formerly, and disability, and inconvenience, from same is much increased since his former examination by the Board of Examining Surgeons, Bolinas Md, that he appoints Riley E. Wright of 63 W. Fayette St, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim; that his residence is No. \_\_\_\_\_ street, of \_\_\_\_\_ the County of Calvert, and State of Maryland; and his post office address is Walville P.O.
