DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore ss:

On the 24th day of November A. D. one thousand nine hundred and nine personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the county and state aforesaid Hester Boom, aged 63 years, a resident of Baltimore City, County of Maryland, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the Act of Congress Approved, April 19, 1908.

That she is the widow of James Boom, who was enrolled under the name of James Boom, at as a private in Co. "C" 39th Regt. U.S.C. Vol. Inf. and honorably discharged December 4, 1865, having served ninety days or more during the late civil war.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services if any.)

That he was not in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above.

That she was married under the name of Hester O'Romy, to said soldier at Baltimore Md on the 6th day of May, 1880, by Rev Robert Steele; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage; that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had been previously married the soldier's first marriage dissolved by death.

and that neither she nor said soldier married otherwise than is stated above.

That the said soldier died November 18, 1909, at Baltimore City Md; that she was not divorced from him, and that she has not remarried since his death.

That the said soldier left the following-named children who are now living and under sixteen years of age, to wit:

- List of children with fields for name, age, and birthplace.

That she has not heretofore applied for pension Her deceased husband was a pensioner under Act of Feb. 6, 1907, Certificate No 172780

She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, David H. Stanton, 528 W. Franklin Street of Baltimore, State of Maryland her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, and to receive therefor a fee of \$10.
