I am Attorney of record in the case of
Rebecca Emolds widow of James Emolds
late Pvt. Co. 39. U.S. Inf. I recognize
the two declarations shown me, both dated
July 17, 1893, (Widows Book #1 and War Book
Vol 1) as having been prepared by myself
including dates affixed to the affidavits. I
also recognize as genuine the signatures and
seals of S. Magruder Putnam, Jr. to
each of aforesaid. I have also examined the
affidavits of Elizabeth Loday and Sarah C.
Carney executed July 19, 1893 and filed in
the Pension Bureau Aug 15, 1893 with the
widows declaration for Emolds accused pension.
Being informed that Elizabeth Loday and
Sarah C. Carney have ever to my ^{little} knowledge
to my office, and that on July 19, 1893 I have no
doubt of the truth of their statements. I
prepared and dated both applications on July 17,
1893 and sent the same to Mr Putnam to
be sworn, supposing, I have no doubt, that
she would bring two witnesses that day to
subscribe to the accused declaration. The
Magistrate held the accused declar. until
