She has a crazy daughter but I do not know her age. She is the youngest child and I think she is about 16 years old. Yes sir, I know that Jim Ennolds and Rebecca have always lived together as man and wife ever since their marriage & up to his death. They were always known and recognized as husband and wife since before the war. Yes sir, I went and testified for Rebecca once before. I went with Rebecca and Miss Sunday here to an office on Saratoga and St Paul Sts. I met a lady who wrote down my statement. Yes sir, I was sworn to that statement by a Magistrate at another office on St Paul St. I only signed one paper. I had never been there before and I have never been there but one time. I did not know any of the people at any of the places I went. I testified that I knew Rebecca was married, just as I have now told you.
