1864 the Rheumatism & Misery in my breast  
& Stomach & weak eyes from the early  
Searvis & I contracted my disability at  
South Carolina about December 1864 & first of 65  
& my disability have continued ever since discharge  
to present time & when I was discharge & stop  
in Baltimore City & I fore quit the Tombers of the  
houses & lived in Mountgumery st & in York st & in  
Leadenshall st 902 & ever since discharge I have  
been treated by the Opencery Dr on Hill st  
near Randome st & I go to him all the time  
for my Disability & my occupation since  
discharge from the Searvis have been about  
more or less all the time & I am not able to do much  
of any thing I am a disabled man from  
from manual labor & I was in  
the 39 Regiment Cavalry U. S. C. of 1864
