We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Disease of Stomach, Rheumatism, Affection of Spine and Back and General Debility.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for ORIGINAL
[Original, increase, restoration, &c.]
Claims to suffer with pain across the stomach. Has pain on exertion; much worse in damp weather.
Rheumatism in the shoulders and across the neck and back.
Makes no claim for affection of the spine.
Claims to be in very debilitated condition as result of advanced age and unable to perform hard manual labor.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 1 inches; weight, 120 pounds; age, 75 years. General physical condition bad.

Has feeble appearance. Skin wrinkled. Muscles wasted and flabby. Characteristic appearance of senile debility.
No evidence of any affection of the stomach. States that he suffers with cramps after eating or exertion. Liver and spleen are normal. No hemorrhoids.
Rheumatism: Marked crepitation in both shoulders with pain on manipulation.
No deformity of the joints or apparent limitation of motion.
Sensitiveness of muscles about the shoulders, over and between the scapulae and over the back of the neck with pain when moving the arms and rotating the head.
Sensitiveness in the lumbar and sacral regions with pain when stooping, lifting and rising to the erect position. Lumbar muscles are atrophied.
Heart: Apex in normal position. Action is weak but regular. No valvular lesion.
Lungs are in healthy condition.
Claimant would be unable to perform hard manual labor by reason of advanced age.
No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 8/18 rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism for that caused by senile debility and 12/18 for that caused by
