Enoch Water was enrolled on the 26th day of Nov, 1863, at Somerset Md, as a Private in Co. A, 19th Regiment of U. S. Colored Brigade, to serve 3 years.

He is reported on Muster Roll from Org. to April 30/64
present for duty: May & June 64. Absent
"Sick in Reg. Hosp since June 26, 1864": July
& Aug. present "Detached Com^d Dept^x": Sept
Oct and Nov. & Dec 64 present for duty: Jan
& Feb 65. absent "on detached service at Jones
Landing Va.": March & April and May & June 65
present for duty: July & Aug and Sept & Oct
65 present "Detached service per So^x & Aug 21, 65:
Nov. & Dec 65 and to Oct. 31, 66. present for duty:
Nov & Dec 66. present, "In arrest."

He was mustered out of service, with
Co. Jan. 15, 1867, at Brownsville Tex.
Records on file do not show rupture of left side alleged,
nature of sickness above reported, nor afford any additional
information as to disability during service.
