I never knew Matus until after I came out
of hospital at Benedict Md in 1864, and
then came with the regt up to this city and
it was while we were at Camp Belvoir
this city that I became acquainted with Matus
who was a member of my company, - and directly after
the battle of Petersburg Va in June 1864, he complained
of rheumatism and had a breaking out on
his stomach and sides - He told me that it was
a breaking out of scrofula and rheumatism, I never
saw the breaking out - The rheumatism which he
then and now complains of much, he said appeared
him in the legs and body in general - He was sent
to hospital from Petersburg but I don't know what name,
but came back to regt and went to Texas, with us
and was always complaining of rheumatism
and complained of rheumatism, never saw him worked or with
his clothing off or partly so, never saw his
person or private or heard him to have
anything the matter with them.
Have never heard him complaining anything
but rheumatism and breaking out.

I made about two or three years ago in the
office and it was read to me and I was sworn to it by some
of these doctors from Lafayette - I don't know whether by observation or breaking out
and I have done today - formerly lived Moses Donsey
