and 46 Saratoga St. Bal resident of Baltimore County of  
Annamundel and State of Maryland, to me well known, and whom I certify to be  
respectable and intelligent, and entitled to full credit and belief, and who being duly sworn according to law, declared that

that they distinctly their comrade John Jolly was  
taken sick at or near Petersburg Va, ~~also~~ which so afflicted  
him for duty as a soldier that he was relieved & detailed  
in ~~cook~~ house. He became worse & sent to the hospital  
This Hospital was called the General Hospital & was  
located near Fortress Monroe, Va. That when their  
company left for Texas, John Jolly remained  
in the Hospital; but that in about two months  
to the best of their knowledge, he joined two regiments  
at Indianola, Texas. That during their stay  
in Texas they were intimate with said Jolly &  
knew him to suffer as above & seemed to grow  
continually worse, was detailed as an orderly &  
relieved from anything like heavy duty. That  
<sup>believe they</sup> they first saw the soldier at Port Oaca, where his  
Co was stationed. That his Co. & Regt was stationed  
at City Point Va when they left for Texas

And they have no interest in the claim of Mrs Jolly for Pension
