cousin John Jolly was prostrated with cough,
fevers in his breast & disease of the lungs at or
near Petersburg Va, about July 1864 which so
unfitted him for duty as a soldier that he
was relieved and detailed in cook house. Even this
seemed to much for him as his disease was chang-
ing into Consumption; - coughing terribly etc. - & was
sent to Hospital. He was a good soldier & a strictly
temperate man & always (when his health permitted)
ready for duty. When his company left for Texas
John Jolly remained in the hospital from
whence he believes he was discharged
