

On this 15th day of Mar A. D. 1882 in and for the State and City aforesaid, personally appeared Mitchell Bailey late of Co 7 1st S. C. I resident of 310 Montgomery St County of Balto and State of Maryland, to me well known, and whom I certify to be

respectable and intelligent, and entitled to full credit and belief, and who being duly sworn according to law, declared that he has perfect & personal knowledge that his comrade John Jolly was prostrated with cough, pains in his breast & disease of the lungs at or near Petersburg Va, about July 1864 which so unfitted him for duty as a soldier that he was relieved and detailed in cook house. Even then seemed to recover for him as his disease was changing into Consumption; - coughing terribly etc. - & was sent to Hospital. He was a good soldier & a strictly temperate man & always (when his health permitted) ready for duty. When his company left for Texas John Jolly remained in the hospital from whence he believes he was discharged.
