the first part of December 1863, subsequent to
that time I was on detached duty all the
time. Dr. Wrofe who was with the Regt. most
of the time was killed while in the service
in Texas. I am unable to state the whereabouts
of any other Asst. Surgeon of said Regiment
if living.
