A. No sir, I am pretty positive he was not married then.

Q. Can you state the present whereabouts of any of the commissioned officers of your company?

A. No sir, the Surgeon of our Regt who ^{was with us} while in Texas was killed while we were there, his name was Mess, Dr. Augusta was out with us excepting in the first part of our service.
