

WIDOW'S DECLARATION FOR PENSION OR INCREASE OF PENSION.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 9th day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety one, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public of the City, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Hester Boston, aged 44 years, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the Pension provided by Acts of Congress granting pension to widows: That she is the widow of Wm Boston, who enlisted under the name of Wm Boston, at Co F. 30th U.S.C., on the 27 day of Feb, A. D. 1880, in Rebellion (Company and Regiment of Service, if in the Army; or Vessel and Rank, if in the Navy.)

in the war of Rebellion, who contracted a severe cold while in the service and died from consumption, the result of same (State nature of wounds, and all circumstances attending them, or the disease and manner in which it was incurred, in either case showing soldier's death to have been the sequence.)

on the 27 day of Feb, A. D. 1880, who bore at the time of his death the rank of Corporal in service aforesaid ("In the service aforesaid," or otherwise.) that she was married under the name of Hester Henry to said Wm Boston, on the 10 day of June A. D. 1869, by Jas H Ockray, at Annapolis Md, there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married - neither previously married (If either have been previously married, so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.)

; that she has to present date remained his widow; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate children yet surviving who were under sixteen years of age at father's death, viz:

that she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance. two are dead - one given & married (For such children as are not under her care claimant should account)

one Mary Adeline yet under my care & maintenance

that she has not in any manner engaged in, or aided or abetted, the rebellion in the United States; that a prior application has not been filed (If prior application has been filed, either by soldier or widow, so state, giving number assigned to it.)

; that she hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Jewell & Nicholson of Washington DC, her attorney, to prosecute the above claim; that her residence is No. 309 Lee street Baltimore City and her Post Office address is 309 Lee St - Baltimore Md.
