Ball entered ulnar side of left
arm 2 inches above wrist joint & is
sited on inner aspect of wrist
passing under extensor tendon.

on - Half #4 - for arm -

Same missile entered abdomen 4 inches
to left of umbilicus & passing through
muscular tissues was extracted 12 inches
below umbilicus - #2 for abdomen

Wound was fractured wrist most stiff & cold
Considerable weakness of hand
No of abdomen painful in bad weather
Some muscular tenderness
