 wound of arm, and was sent to G. H. Aug. 8/64. He
 entered L'Overture G. H. Alexandria Va Aug. 9/64, with
 flesh wound left arm, was furloughed Oct. 3/64, re.
 admitted Nov 2/64, and discharged from service Sept 3/65
 Red cards of this hospital show him wounded near Peters-
 burg Va July 30/64
 No record found of soldier's treatment for any disability
 other than as above indicated
