On this 25th day of July 1866 personally appeared before me a clerk of a Court of Record, Benjamin Malone aged 43 years a resident of Baltimore and State of Maryland who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States duly enrolled at the Baltimore pension agency, at the rate of \$4.00 per month by reason of disability incurred in the military service of the United States in Company G 19th V.S.L.T. and that his present physical condition is such that he believes himself entitled to receive an increased pension of the third grade provided for in the first section of the supplementary pension act approved June 6th 1864. He further declares that he is disabled in the following manner to wit:
1st By a shot through the arm breaking the bone. Also by a shot through the bowels. The shot through the arm disabling him from doing any manual labor.
