bilicus & issued to the right of it 2
inches. Painful during changes of
weather. Rated one halfBall entered outer aspect ulnar side
fore arm 3 inches above the wrist frac-
turing ulna and issued opposite.
Bone united - atrophy of fore arm -
cannot close the fingers into the palm.
