DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

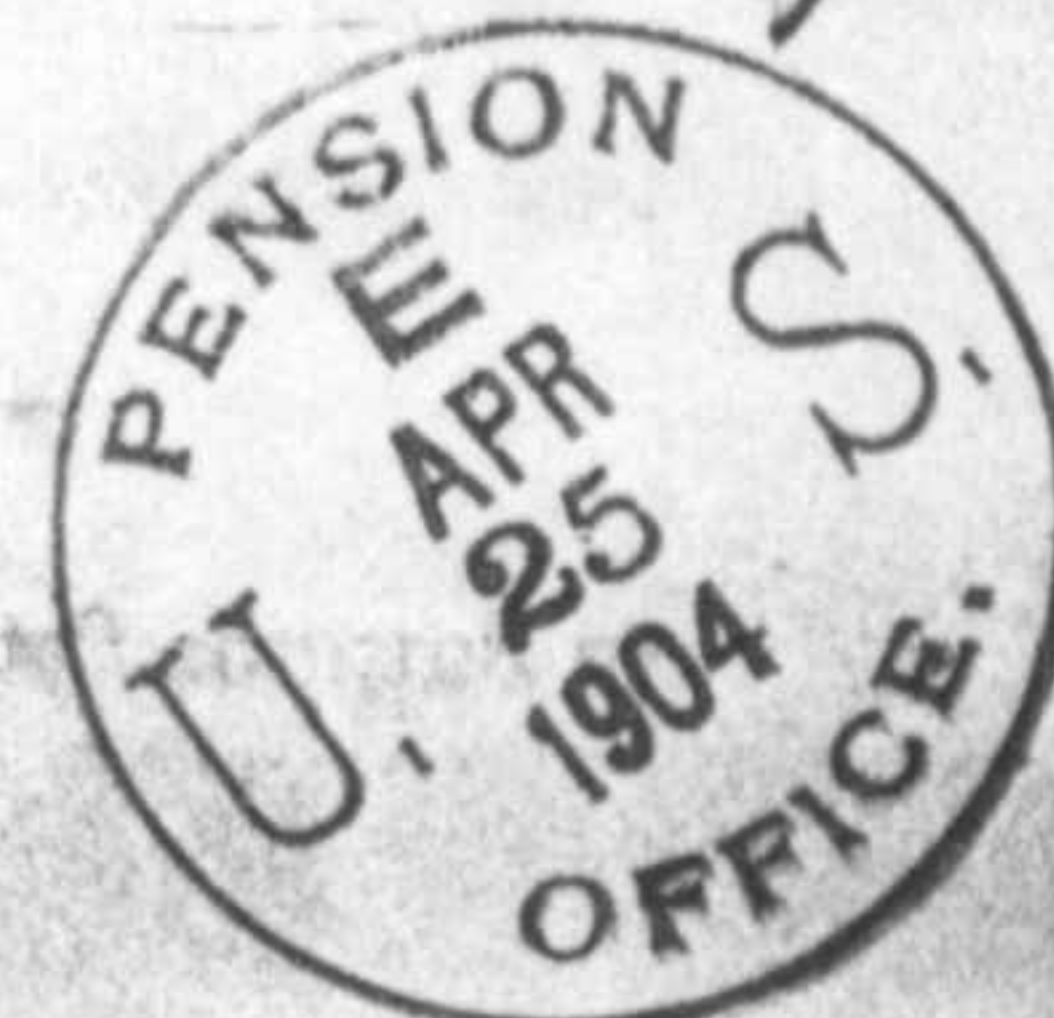
