Receipt is acknowledged of the evidence submitted in support of the claim for allowance toward burial expenses of the veteran named above.

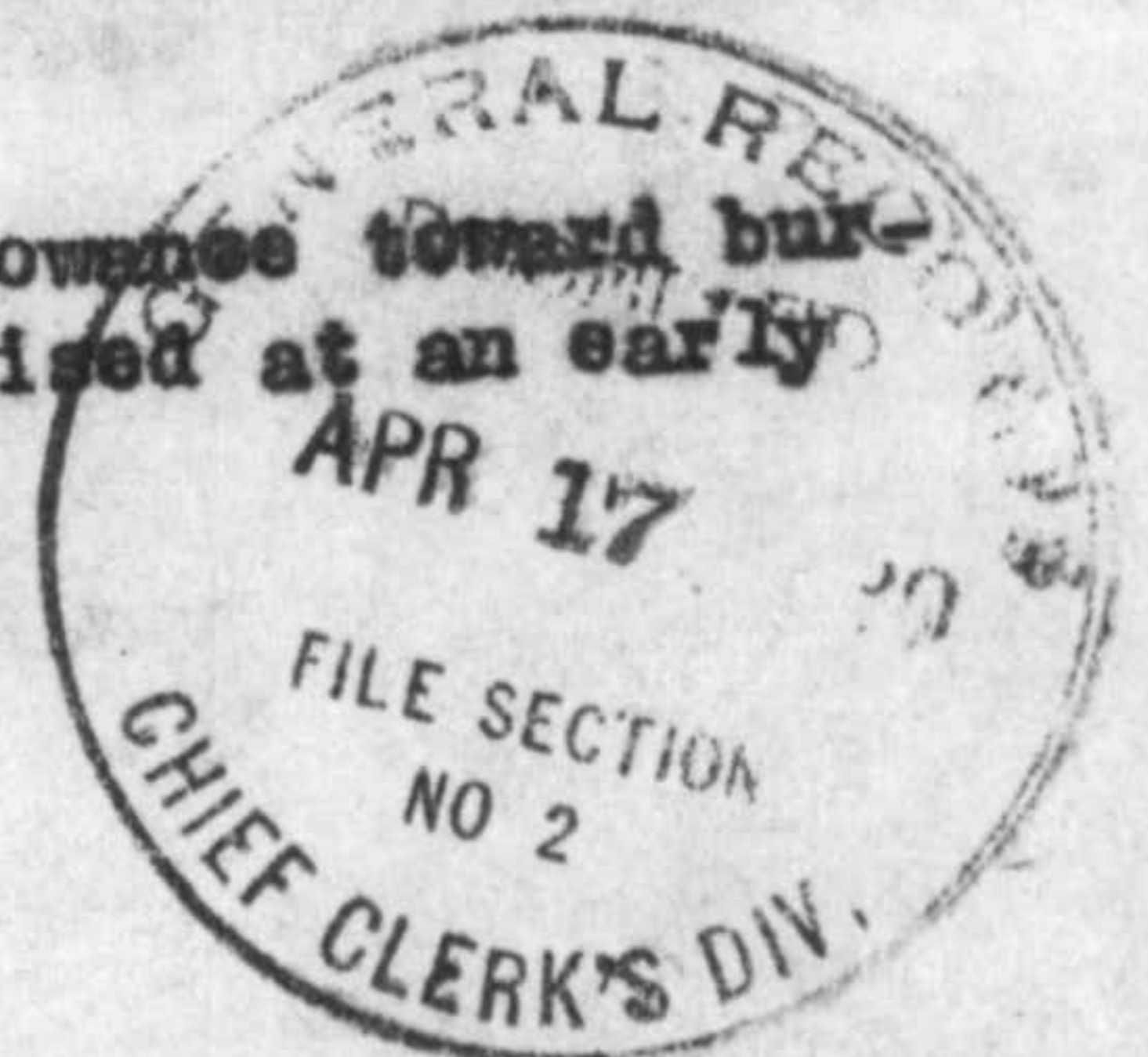
