

# DECLARATION FOR AN INVALID PENSION.

This Invalid Pension Declaration must be executed before a Judge or Clerk of a Court of Record, and if before the Judge, the Clerk thereof will certify said Judge's official capacity and signature, and attest the same under the seal of the Court.

A Justice of the Peace must not authenticate this paper. If he does, the work is utterly useless, and must be all done over again before a Judge or Clerk of a Court of Record, as above stated.

ON THIS 26th day of December A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy one, personally appeared before me, (1) A. Clerk of the (2) Superior Court, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Joshua Wallace, aged 31 years, a resident of the (3) City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Joshua Wallace who (4) Enlisted in the service of the United States at Camp Belger in the State of Maryland, on or about the 23 day of May in the year 1864, as a Private in Company E commanded by M. Patterson Capt Co E in the 19th Regiment of (5) M. S. C. Troops commanded by Joseph Perkins in the war of 1861, and was honorably discharged at Brownsville in the State of Louisiana, on or about the 15th day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven; that while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, (6)

did receive a few shot wounds, in the small of the back. The Ball entering along side of the spine column passing inward and downward, the Ball extirpated about 3 weeks from date of entrance wound has opened and suppurated since, some specks of Bone come out, said wound cured on or about the 4th day of Aug 1864, about 11 A.M. while going for bucket of water, my Regiment being front of Petersburg Va there was a shell burst on the rear of me, and one of the balls striking as aforesaid, was carried to my camp by four comrades upon 2 stretchers, after which I was sent to old field Hospital, from there to Summit Home Hospital at Plattsburg. That since leaving, I have not entered the military or naval service since date of discharge - don't know where to find Officers

That since leaving the said service, this applicant has resided in the (3) City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been (7) Attending a Store

That prior to his entry into the service above named, he was a man of good, sound physical health, being when enrolled, a (8) Labourer

That now he is (9) disabled from obtaining his subsistence from manual labor in consequence of his above named injuries, received in the service of the United States.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Invalid Pension Roll of the United States, by reason of the disabilities above stated, and revoking and countermanding all other authority that may have been given, he hereby constitutes and appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Thomas A. Campbell

Resident of (3) Baltimore, his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim, and obtain the Pension Certificate that may be issued. That his Post Office is at Baltimore

County of Baltimore State of Maryland

That his domicile or place of abode is (10) No 174 Dover St - in the City of Baltimore

If applicant makes his mark, let two persons who write their names attest his signature. The Officer administering the oath cannot be one of the attesting parties.
