DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

Note.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of clerk of court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

day of Aug 1864, in Co K 19th U. S. C.

Aug in the service of the United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at 18 66, on the day of , 18 66

That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of (Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled).

Rheumatism, disease of kidneys & back
affection of heart, spleen & disease
of chest.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has cy 626009 applied for pension under application No. That he is

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That he make this declaration for the purpose of being on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints
