Pensioned from *July 25, 1890*, at \$ *6.* per month for *rheumatism*
and disease of rectum, and dropped June 4, 1893.

Original declaration, Act of *June 27, 1890*, filed *July 25, 1890*
 alleged *rheumatism, affection of stomach, back and*
chest, piles, disease of eyes, and shortness of breath.
Oct 17, 1891, Alleged disease and disease of rectum
deafness of left ear broken foot affection of
right leg. Dropped
Jan 29, 1896, Alleged rheumatism, piles, disease
of chest, and shortness of breath. Rejected
Sept 2, 1896, Alleged rheumatism, disease of
heart, piles, and disease of chest. Rejected.
