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30 to the support of my mother
 31 or the children. At one time
 32 he gave me 75 cents and at
 33 another time he gave me
 34 \$1.00. It was a long time ago
 35 when he gave me the 75 cents, but
 36 he gave me the \$1.00 the last
 37 pension money he got.

38 Yes, I remember my mother
 39 marrying Isaac Handy. I was
 40 present at the marriage. I
 41 was about grown at the time.
 42 The ceremony was performed
 43 by a minister named Fitzhugh
 44 Don't know what year it
 45 was. I think they lived together
 46 some three or four years
 47 and then he deserted her.
 48 No, she never got any divorce
 49 from either Isaac Handy or
 50 Robert Barnes. She was never
 51 married except to Isaac Handy
 52 since I can remember. She has
 53 not married or lived with any
 54 man as his wife since Robert
 55 Barnes died. I don't know where
 56 Handy is - some three or four
 57 years ago I heard he was dead
 58 & some one had heard of his
 59 death and told the ones who gave me
 60 the information. I have heard the foregoing
 61 read and it is correct as written
