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done the writing in my first application in the summer of 1890. No sir, I do not know Tobias Stewart he never acted as my witness as I know of - I never met a man by that name, I was living at 123 Selman St. when I first applied for Pension, I was at Lloyds office after I made my application & before my Pension was granted I swore to a Paper Cant say as to Contents of paper, was sworn by Mr Warner, Cant say as to date or how long it was after I had applied. I was there also as a witness for John Thomas, that was while my claim was pending. Mr Warner swore me in Thomas case I was acting as a witness for Thomas. I cant say who were present at these ~~the~~ times other than Thomas Warner, Lloyd & myself. Yes. I have met a young lady Clark and a Clerk who is a small thin fellow & wears glasses, I cant say when I first met them think it was the summer after I applied for Pension No. I did not meet either of them when I first applied for Pension. No sir, they were never sworn with me at anytime, & I cant remember of either of them signing any of my claim papers, & Mr Lloyd done all my writing in my claim. Yes I made application for an increase through Mr Lloyd some time during the fall after my Pension was granted. I was then living at
