Q Your 2nd application dated 15 Oct 1891 appears in the writing of persons other than Mr Lloyd, probably O. W. Beale, and Beale with the lady Clerk B. B. Truero appear as your identifying witnesses?

A I will say that I may be mistaken as to who wrote that paper probably it was the young man Beale, it was about then that I met him first & he probably done the writing. If he & the lady Clerk acted as witnesses I never knew it, I think they were present at the time, & it was the first I saw of either of them, never met them before that day. I am sure they were never sworn with me.
