 Feby 1863 or 64 ~~and served~~ till Dec 1865 or
 1866.

I do not know this Clerk, Cant
 remember of ever meeting a person
 named Robert Barnes, and I am
 sure I never acted as an
 identifying witness for this man
 in his pension claim. If I ever
 met this man I do not now
 remember it. I was living at
 my present home during the
 entire year of 1890. I cant say,
 if I was in Baltimore during
 the month of July that year, I
 probably was here in this city
 during the year 1890, but as
 to month or date I cant say. I
 do not know Virgil Dawkins &
 was never in his or any ones
 Oyster or Clam house on Warner
 St, or any other St this city. I never
 signed any ones pension papers
 but my own. I am a pensioner
