I lived within 1/2 square of him for
 8 months in 1893. & saw him daily -
 previous to that I lived in 4 or 5
 squares of him & would see him at
 least once each month, since 1893
 I have lived within 4 squares of him
 & have seen him about once every
 two weeks. And I know from personal
 knowledge that he has off & on during
 the entire time been confined to the
 house by reason of pains & aches
 which I understood from him was
 rheumatism. I cant say as to
 any doctor of his. I understood from
 him that Dr Pepper was treating
 him. I consider that he has been
 1/2 disabled from any work since
