Dear Madam:

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Receipt is acknowledged of form 5036, executed and submitted by you in support of your claim for reimbursement from accrued pension in the case of Jane Hensell, deceased pensioner.

In support of your claim, it is necessary that you submit the funeral bill. This bill must be itemized, must bear the name of the pensioner, and, if paid, must be receipted in the name of the undertaking firm by a member of the firm who must sign his name in full and state his official capacity. If payment thereof is shown to have been made by some person other than yourself, that person must sign the enclosed form 5328. In the event the bill is unpaid, the undertaker must sign the form 5328. George Lansdale, by whom the pensioner was nursed and by whom the bill of Dr. W. Atwell Jones was paid, must also sign form 5328. ✓

It is noted that George Lansdale by whom the pensioner was nursed and by whom the doctor's bill was paid has executed the top of page 3 of form 5036 as a disinterested witness. Inasmuch as he does not appear to be disinterested, it is necessary that you submit a supplemental affidavit from a disinterested person, furnishing in an affidavit sworn to before a notary public the following information: Did the pensioner leave any property? If so, state its character and value. The affiant must further state his means of knowledge of the above requested statements and further state how long he has known the pensioner.

You stated on form 5036 that the pensioner was buried in London National Cemetery and indicated that no expense was incurred in connection with the burial in that cemetery. An explanation as to why no cemetery expense was incurred should be furnished.
