

appeared George France, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him, deposes and says My age is 49 years - Post office address 918 N. E. 10th St - Occupation Rat Catcher - I served in C. 7. 9th U.S. C.V. and knew the applicant from the time he joined the company to the present. In 1864 at Fort Harrison I remember he claimed he had been struck on one of his hips with a piece of shell and the Capt. M. Royer told him that he must get up. he was laying down and said he could not get up and we carried up him up to the doctor who examined him and sent to the hospital and I think he remained there most of the time till his discharge. He was sent to Fort's Monroe hospital and I was sent to the same hospital after I was wounded and then ^{he was} complaining of something, but of just what I won't state what. See I remember now the Capt used to say to him "Doesn't it are you having hearing" he appeared to me to be hard of hearing, more on one side than the other and I believe he is yet but I can't say which side or when or how he got his deafness. See him two or three times a year since discharge, and he complains of dizziness but just what I can't say position - About two years ago I went before a Judge on Council St. and begged by word of mouth for Capt. Royer to know his name I don't know where he is now - I was told he was in the hospital at Fort's Monroe.
