In response to your call of the 18th, received the 21st ultimo (L.319-361,965), relative to the case of William H. Butler, deceased, late of Co. G, 7" U.S.C.Inf., Cert. #606,728, you are advised that Rosa Butler, of #1435 Ward Street, Baltimore, Md., filed on March 13, 1908, an application for accrued pension in this Bureau as widow of William H. Butler, who she stated died on the 6th day of September, 1907; that she was married to said William H. Butler on October 2, 1901, at Baltimore, Md.; that her name prior to said marriage was Rosa Brown.
