In response to your attached letter of the 15th, and card received the 21st instant (L.319-361,965), for information as to whether the accrued pension in the case of William H. Butler, deceased, late of Co. G, 7th U.S.C. Inf., Ctf. No. 606,728, was paid to Rosa Taylor, you are advised that the claim for accrued pension filed by Rosa Butler, as widow of said soldier, has been abandoned, as stated in my letter of December 5, 1910.

The U. S. Pension Agent, Washington, D. C., informed this Bureau, under date of September 23, 1907, that the name of William H. Butler, a pensioner under Ctf. #606,728, and who was last paid to September 4, 1907, had been dropped from the pension roll by reason of death on September 6, 1907.
