I have only seen her to speak to once in the last 17 years to the best of my knowledge. That was two or three years ago to the best of my knowledge. I knew William Ballard, the blind man. I knew him before the war. He became blind some three or four years after he came out of the service. I don't know whether Annie was ever married to him or not, or whether they lived together. I don't know where Henry Thomas lives, but I think he told me it was somewhere near Wolfe street. He and Annie had no children to my knowledge.
