He was blind two or three years, not over three I think. I never knew of any sickness he had. I never saw him during his last sickness. He did not live long after being taken down. I could not tell what year he died or how long ago it was. I have seen her often till she went to Philadelphia but I have not seen her since. She has never remarried that I know of.
