DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace.

MARYLAND, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of

John W. Hayes, who enlisted under the name of

U. S. Infantry Volunteers, and served at least ninety days in the late War

(Name of State, and whether Infantry, Cavalry, or Artillery.) of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED

4th 1865 23rd March, and died November 29 1908 That he was not employed in

substitution and revocation, A. Parlett Lloyd of BALTIMORE. MD.

her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS, payable as prescribed by law.
