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wrote his former affidavit as was the same  
man who swore him to the paper. It will be  
observed that this affidavit bears two dates of  
execution but affiant swears he was then but  
one day. The affidavit is in the handwriting  
of Mr Lloyd - well known to your Examiner.  
It therefore appears that Mr Lloyd himself  
was in the habit of swearing witnesses and  
subsequently having C. E. Warner execute the  
juror. The fact that the juror has a  
subsequent date to that in the caption of the  
affidavit corroborates the witness that Lloyd  
- the man who wrote the paper - did swear him.

I respectfully recommend that this case be  
referred to Law Div. for consideration of other  
cases of like character tending to the disbarment  
of A. Parker Lloyd for illegal practices.
