

28 my understanding though I forget just when she died. I
 29 knew the next wife of Heath whose name was Sadonia Heath
 30 and she is dead too though I pay no attention to dates
 31 of such deaths having no particular interest in the women.
 32 The next wife of Jacob Heath was the woman he left at his
 33 death and I was not acquainted with her prior to their
 34 marriage. Jacob Heath was divorced from one of his wives
 35 but I forget which one it was. Heath never had two wives
 36 at the same time and stood high in the church.

37 Q. I am informed that Heath had still another wife?

38 A. It is a mistake, he had no other wife, he was mar-
 39 ried four times and first to Frederica and then to her sis-
 40 ter Harried and next comes Sadonia and lastly the woman
 41 Annie the old man left at his death. I knew all of the
 42 women that Jacob Heath was married to though I never went
 43 to the burial of any of them. Heath and I attend different
 44 churches. I am not related to this soldier or his widow
 45 and I have no financial interest in this claim. I have
 46 no information concerning the marital history of Annie Heath.
 47 I was sworn to the affidavit I signed in this claim. I
 48 have heard the affidavit read and will state I cannot carry
 49 those dates in my head and never stated them in testifying
 50 by affidavit and Mrs Heath must have given them in as she
 51 was with me at the execution of the affidavit.

52 I have lived in Baltimore continuously for fifty odd
 53 years and so has Jacob Heath who was a shoe maker with a
 54 shop in Warner street and then in Calhoun street and for a
 55 time in Druid Hill avenue. I was often in his shop and at
 56 his residence, was in his residence many a time, was there
 57 the week before he died, and Heath used to call on me in
 58 sickness. I believe I was in a position to have known of
 59 any other marriage he may have contracted unless he was
 60 very secret about it and it is my honest belief that the
 61 four women I have named is all that he had. I have heard
 62 the foregoing deposition read and it is correct.
