1 I am 65 or 66 years old, occupation housekeeper, and  
2 post office address 920 Warner st, Baltimore Md.  
3 I am the widow of Samuel R. Ringold a laborer - and I have  
4 lived in this city over fifty years and my home was on  
5 Kent Island in Queen Annes County Md prior to coming here.  
6 I knew Jacob Heath who died in Druid Hill avenue in Balti-  
7 more from the time I was 13 or 14 years old living on Kent  
8 Island, knew him just before he went into the army and I  
9 may be older than I have stated but do not know my exact  
10 age, on Kent Island I lived with my parents on the place of  
11 Mr --- forget his name, was sixteen years old at date of  
12 leaving Kent Island for this city to live permanently, and  
13 I recollect when Jacob Heath was drafted and he was living  
14 on Kent and not so far from us, forget his owners name, he  
15 served in the army with two brothers of mine, this same  
16 Jacob Heath I mean, and at his discharge he returned to his  
17 home on Kent Island and lived there for a time before loca-  
18 ting in this city. I knew the mother of Mr Heath whose  
19 name was Hannah Robinson. I have forgotten whether Heath  
20 came to Baltimore to live before I came and my memory for  
21 things like that is not so good. We have both been in Bal-  
22 timore a long time is the best answer I can make to that  
23 question. Here in Baltimore Heath and I attended the same  
24 church until here of late. I have gone to his house to  
25 call and he has come to my house and was a friend of my late  
26 husband Samuel R. Ringold.
