28 property he left to her at his death. I did not know any
 29 former wife that Heath may have had. He was a good shoe maker.
 30 I was not a witness to the marriage of Charles Daily to
 31 Annie Satchell and recall nothing concerning their marriage
 32 that I may have heard at the time though I was often at
 33 their house. I do not know in fact that she married Daily
 34 lawfully though I would suppose so as she has always been
 35 such a nice woman. I have known of but one child that Annie
 36 has given birth to and that is the son by Jacob Heath - his
 37 name is Arnett Heath. I have no financial interest in
 38 this claim for pension. I did not know Charles Daily prior
 39 to the time he began living with Annie Daily as her husband.
 40 They lived together as man and wife and were so considered
 41 but I am wholly unable at this time to recall the length
 42 of thier married life. I was sworn to the affidavit that
 43 I signed in this claim and yet I do not recall what the affi-
 44 davit was to cover and just answered the questions that
 45 the clerk asked me. If the affidavit does not mention that
 46 Annie was the wife of Charles Daily it is not my fault as
 47 I answered the questions of the notary who did the writing.
 48 I knew this woman by the name of Annie Satchell at first
 49 and then by the name of Annie Daily and next as Annie Heath
 50 and she has borne no other name nor lived with any other
 51 man in the marital relation to my knowledge. My acquaintance
 52 with Annie Heath has not been continuous and for a number of
 53 years we lost track of each other, I used to travel with fami-
 54 lies as a nurse and was in Philadelphia and other places, and
 55 it was for fifteen or eighteen years that Annie and I did not
 56 see much of each other. She has lived in Baltimore all the
 57 time I would suppose though I cannot swear that she has.
 58 I have heard the foregoing deposition read and it is correct.
 59 It was prior to the marriage of Annie Satchell to Jacob Heath
 60 that I was absent from Baltimore as a nurse.
