29 I knew no former husband she may have had.

30 My father Jacob Heath was from Kent Island Md and he was
31 not married to any woman there I often heard my mother
32 Frederica say. He married her in Baltimore and she was
33 his first wife and after she died my father was married
34 only to the other three women I have mentioned.

35 I have always lived in Baltimore and used to work in
36 the shop of my father Jacob Heath as he was a shoe maker
37 the same as I and ran this shop at one time and gave it
38 up to move into north Baltimore after his mixup with
39 the wife Harriet Bordley. My father lived with no other
40 women in the marital relation and he had no outside children.

41 Q. I have been informed that Jacob Heath was married
42 five times? A. It is a mistake and I am old enough to
43 straighten that out. My mother Frederica Brown was the
44 first wife that Jacob Heath had after his discharge from the
45 army. I dont think he was old enough to have had any wife
46 prior to his service in the army. He often spoke of his
47 army service to me. I have no financial interest in this
48 claim for pension. I have heard the foregoing deposition
49 read and it is correct.
