

# DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, SS:

On this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve personally appeared before me, a Justice J. McRenee within and for the City and state aforesaid, Jacob Heath, who, being duly sworn according to law

declares that he is 69 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore City County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Benedick Hall under the name of

Jacob A. Heath on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1868, as a Private, in Company (C) 19 Regiment U S Colored (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

Troops Volunteer Infantry in the service of the United States, in the Spanish war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED

at Brownville Texa, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1867.

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Queen Ann Co 18 months Baltimore Md 42 years (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of May 11, 1912.
