My mother was a slave and belonged to a family named Turner. I do not know whether Turner or Bush are living. Their post office was Woodville. I lived with this man Bush about a year during the time of the war and I think he went away to the war with the soldiers. My father was also a slave and belonged to Turner's and I lived with them until they died. My father's name was George Lisle. I do not know whether my father and mother were married. Lisle was my name until I married Joseph Ross, the soldier. I had some brothers and sisters, but I cannot tell where they are or whether they are living - if living they are probably down in Prince George County. The names of my brothers were Robert, Allen and Isaac. I know of no other living witnesses to my marriage except Sarah Carroll and my daughter.

I first knew my husband Joseph Ross, about a year prior to our marriage, at Annapolis, Md. He said he had never been before married, and every body said that I was his first wife. He had never been married before to my knowledge. He was old when I married him but I could not tell his age. He told me he had been in the army. I do not know where he was born and raised - do not know where he came from to Annapolis, or whether he was born and raised at Annapolis. There is a Mrs. Snowden living somewhere on Stockton St. - do not know her exact address - who knew
