My dear Mr. Saltzgaber:-

We have become interested in Elizabeth or Eliza Jackson, whose husband, James E. Jackson - Company H, 19 U. S. C. Inf. was drawing a pension from the Government. The number of this pension was 1031133, and we understand that this has recently been stopped as the Pension Department had been informed that he had had two other wives; namely, Rachael Chew and Sarah Weeks. It is claimed by the Department that the death of Sarah Weeks has not been proven.

We have searched the records at the Health Department, but owing to the fact that the records extend only back to 1875, we have been unable to find anything in this line. I am enclosing a certificate from Dr. Gorter to substantiate this statement.

We shall greatly appreciate anything you may be able to do towards having the pension renewed as we feel she is fully entitled to it and is certainly very much in need of it.
