In claim No. 1,031,133, of Eliza Jackson, as widow of James A. Jackson, Co. H, 19 U. S. C. Inf., whose post office address is 557 West Biddle street, Baltimore, Md., it is desired to determine whether the soldier secured a divorce from the claimant during the period of his residence at the National Military Home, Va. He appears to have been admitted to the Home July 13, 1912, where he died June 25, 1914. Please cause a search to be made of the divorce records of all courts having jurisdiction in divorce cases and secure a certified copy of the decree, if any such was obtained.

In submitting your report, please state the court, or courts, the records of which have been searched, and that the courts named are the only ones having jurisdiction in divorce cases for the period searched.
