In the above-cited claim for pension there should be furnished the affidavit of the attending physician, giving full clinical history of the soldier's last illness, showing the duration thereof; the remote and immediate cause, as well as the date, of death; whether there were any complications or contributory causes, and, if so, their nature and to what extent they were factors in the fatal result; also, a certified copy of the public record of the soldier's death, if such record exists.
