 In claim of No 972952, Jane Jordan, widow of James  
 Jordan, Landsman, U S Navy, I have the honor to report that  
 the pension check was delivered to pensioner the day after  
 I received it and her receipt is made an exhibit to this  
 report. I accompanied pensioner to a bank in Cambridge Md  
 designated by her and assisted her in depositing the check  
 and receiving such cash as she felt that she needed.  
 The pensioner was cautioned against paying any portion  
 of the proceeds of the check as a fee or compensation to  
 any person for service rendered in the prosecution of the  
 claim. Pensioner is rather alert mentally for a colored  
 woman of her age, and does not appear to be so feeble  
 physically.
